Stonewall Riots

An AMERICAN EXPERIENCE/PBS Film

In the early morning hours of June 28, 1969 police raided the Stonewall Inn, a popular gay bar in the Greenwich Village section of NYC. Such raids were not unusual in the late 1960s, an era when homosexual sex was illegal in every state but Illinois. That night, however, the street erupted into violent protests and demonstrations that lasted for the next six days. The Stonewall Riots, as they came to be known, transformed the gay civil rights movement in the U.S. and around the world. Based on the book by David Carter, *Stonewall: The Riots that Sparked the Gay Revolution*, this AMERICAN EXPERIENCE film will draw upon eyewitness accounts and rare archival material to bring this pivotal event to life.

1 2 3 — to 14th St.; then **M14** Delancey St./Clinton St. crosstown bus; east; on 14th St. to Avenue A and 11th St.; walk south one block and east one block.

6 — to Astor Pl.; then **M8** crosstown bus; east; on Eighth St. to Avenue B.

N R W Q — to Union Square; change to **M9** Avenue B bus; south; to Tenth St.

R — to Eighth St. then **M8** crosstown bus; east; on Eighth St. to Avenue B.

L — Canarsie Line to First Ave. at 14th St.; walk south four blocks to Tenth St.; then east 1 1/2 blocks.

F V — to Fourth St. (use Waverly Pl. exit). Then **M8** crosstown bus; east; on Eighth St. to Avenue B.

A C E — to Fourth St. (use Waverly Pl. exit). Then **M8** crosstown bus; east; on Eighth St. to Avenue B.
